Open Container Permit Application

If you would like to provide alcoholic beverages to attendees of your event at no cost and it is a private, invite only event (such as a family reunion or company picnic) you must apply for an Open Container Permit. By State Law, CRS 8.04.820, applicants for an Open Container Permit must meet the following criteria:

- Procedures must be written out and included with application to ensure that underage persons and persons under the influence of alcohol will not obtain or consume fermented malt or alcoholic beverages served at the function.
- Procedures are proposed that are likely to secure and supervise the area and participants
- Applicant must agree to provide sandwiches and other food services at the location during the time of consumption in an amount sufficient to serve the number of persons anticipated to attend
- Applicant must sign that they understand and agree to be personally responsible for and provide financial guarantees to ensure cleaning, trash disposal or repairs necessary as a result of the event (The amount of financial guarantee will be determined by the City)
- Applicant agrees to indemnify and hold the City, its employees and agents harmless (to the extent allowed by law) for all liability claims arising from the event and to provide insurance

1. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE ALLOWED ON THE FIELDS OR IN THE DUGOUTS.
Any player consuming alcohol during a game is suspended for one game and must pay a \$25 fine before being allowed to participate.

2. Ulysses Sports Complex
 - a. Alcoholic beverages are allowed in the parking lot or the pavilion ONLY.
 - b. Must have an alcohol permit while in the parking lot or pavilion.

**NO GLASS BOTTLES OF ANY KIND ARE
ALLOWED AT ANY CITY OF GOLDEN PARK,
PARKING LOT OR PAVILION**

3. Any player or spectator appearing to be intoxicated and posing a danger to themselves or another person within the complex will be:
 - a. Asked to leave the complex of their own accord
 - b. Failure to leave of their own accord shall result in the player being removed from the park by legal means.

4. Any team serving alcohol to minors is subject to a \$100 fine, suspension from the tournament and prosecution by the City of Golden.

The City of Golden Police Department will be called if there are any disturbances or incidents by participants in failing to follow the rules and guidelines set forth by the City of Golden Parks and Recreation Department.
